PAAT is a web-based tool that allows individuals to lodge and track applications for proposed activities such crane operations that may infringe Perth Airport's airspace protected under and Airports (Protection of Airspace) Regulations 1996 (C'th) and pose a hazard to aviation.

PAAT Terms of Use

- The registered user will take all necessary steps to ensure their Protected Airspace Assessment Tool (PAAT) user account login details remain private, and will ensure that account login details are changed and Perth Airport Pty Ltd (PAPL) is immediately notified if the registered user believes their account has been compromised;
- The registered user accepts all responsibility for the accuracy of the information (i.e. heights and locations) input to the Protected Airspace Assessment Tool (PAAT) system through their account;
- All registered users agree to release PAPL, its employees, agents, contractors and consultants against all liabilities (including negligence), costs, claims, expenses or loss, suffered directly or indirectly from reliance on the PAAT system or its outputs and any other information provided by PAPL, and indemnify PAPL, its employees, agents, contractors and consultants against any loss, expense or damage (including reasonable legal costs) suffered or incurred and arising from any negligence by the registered user in connection with the activity or a failure by the registered user to comply with any relevant laws or permits;
- The registered user acknowledges that the airspace around Perth Airport is protected under Part 12 of the *Airports Act 1996* (the Act) and the Airports (Protection of Airspace) Regulations 1996 and that any persons wishing to undertake activities that will result in an intrusion of protected airspace are required to apply to Perth Airport for approval;
- The registered user acknowledges that carrying out a controlled activity without approval is an offence under Section 183 of the Act, and is punishable by a fine of up to 250 penalty units;
- The registered user acknowledges that it is an offence under Section 185 of the Act to contravene any conditions imposed on an approval;
- The registered user acknowledges that Under Section 186 of the Act it is an offence not to give information to the airport operator that is relevant to a proposed controlled activity;
- All care will be taken by Perth Airport to ensure personal information provided is kept private. A copy of Perth Airport's privacy policy can be viewed at perthairport.com.au;
- The registered user may only use the PAAT system for the purposes for which it is intended. PAPL reserves the right to deny the registered user access to the PAAT system for any reason, including for misuse; and
- The registered user acknowledges that the PAAT system may be unavailable by anytime and will ensure the necessary steps are taken to ensure they continue to meet their obligations under the Act.
